Re: Study Leave

Year 11 students are now midway through their final GCSE and BTEC examinations. We continue to be impressed by their efforts and we are sure that they will be successful with continued private revision and attendance to intervention sessions.

From **Monday of the second week back after half-term (13th June)** students only need to attend lessons where they still have coursework outstanding, or have examinations left to complete – **these lessons are compulsory.**

Students must attend school in full school uniform. If a student wishes to study in school in their spare time they are able to use the Sixth Form study area and access the support and guidance there.

To help support your child in subjects with later examination dates further **compulsory sessions** have been included within the normal school day. Unfortunately some of these sessions overlap examinations, so the student would attend after their examination.
